SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

In 1999, the manufacturers' value of shipments of selected types of mining machinery and related equipment totaled \$1.3 billion, a decrease of 20 percent from the 1998 figure of \$1.6 billion. The 1999 total included shipments of \$164.1 million of portable crushing, screening, washing, and combination plants which was a 7.6-percent increase from the 1998 total of \$152.5 million. Underground mining machinery equipment totaled \$333.0 million in 1999, a 32.2-percent decrease from the 1998 total of \$490.9 million. In 1999, stationary, crushing, pulverizing, and screening machinery totaled \$315.6 million, an 8.7-percent decrease from the \$345.7 million reported in 1998. Drills and other mining machinery totaled \$132.3 million in 1999, a 24.4-percent decrease from the \$175.0 million reported in 1998. Portable drilling rigs totaled \$365.9 million in 1999, a 23-percent decrease from the \$475.1 million reported in 1998.
