SPRING WEEKEND

The Spring Formal Saturday night and the Brandywine concert Sunday afternoon are being sponsored by the Student Government Association of New Hampshire College. Admission to both these events is your "activity card".

The concert being given Friday night, however, is being co-sponsored by St. Anselm's College and the Classes of New Hampshire College. The tickets cost \$3 per person. This is a fund-raising activity - not just a student activity. New Hampshire College's share of the profits will be distributed to the classes in proportion to the number of tickets each class sells.

LAND HAS BEEN PURCHASED on the Manchester-Hooksett line for our new campus. Financial plans are now being made so that construction can begin. These plans may be changed at any time.
