Tonight's New England Circle focuses on the epidemic of illegal drug trafficking in the Western Hemisphere. One of the major centers of drug trafficking between Latin America and the United States is Colombia. This evening's co-Discussion Leader is Clara Lopez Obregon, President of the City Council of Bogota, Colombia. She is the first woman to hold that position and is one of the most prominent women in Colombian politics. She is bravely confronting the Colombian drug lords.

Co-Discussion Leader Brad Willis traveled to Bolivia to cover drug trafficking between Bolivia and the United States. Familiar with the situation in Latin America he will share with us excerpts from his award winning documentary. Brad is an Emmy Award winning reporter and has been a broadcast journalist for the past 15 years, the last 3 for WBZ TV-4 in Boston.

Delores Handy, anchor of the weekend broadcast for "News 7" will moderate this Circle gathering. Her journalistic and reporting skills have earned her recognition by her peers.
