THE GLOBAL CITIZEN'S AWARD IS PRESENTED TO AN OUT-

STANDING INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS TRANSCENDED NATIONAL BOUNDARIES; WORKED TIRELESSLY FOR ALL PEOPLES AND THEIR UNIVERSAL HUMAN RIGHTS; FOCUSED THE WORLD'S ATTENTION ON PRESSING HUMAN AND SOCIAL CONDITIONS, BY BEING A MORAL WITNESS AND EFFECTIVE INSTRUMENT OF CHANGE; AND EMBODIED THE LEADERSHIP, RESPONSIBILITIES AND PROMISE OF GLOBAL CITIZENSHIP.

HE FIRST ANNUAL GLOBAL CITIZEN'S AWARD IS PRESENTED TO HIS EXCELLENCY DR. BOUTROS BOUTROS-GHALI, UNITED NATIONS SECRETARY-GENERAL, AT GENERAL. A MONTH AFTER ASSUMING HIS POST AS SECRETARY-GENERAL, AT THE FIRST EVER SECURITY COUNCIL SUMMIT, DR. BOUTROS-GHALI WAS ASKED TO REINTERPRET THE UNITED NATIONS CHARTER OF PREVENTIVE DIPLOMACY, PEACE-MAKING AND PEACE-KEEPING IN A POST-COLD WAR, PRE-MILLENNIUM CONTEXT. HIS MANIFESTO, ENTITLED "AN AGENDA FOR PEACE" AND SUBSEQUENT UNPRECEDENTED ACTIONS SPEAK TO HIS IMAGINATION AND VIGOR.

In his first three months of office, he helped facilitate and signed the El Salvador Peace Accords, dispatched the United Nations Protection Force in the former Yugoslavia, launched the second largest peace-keeping operation, United Nations Transitions Authority in Cambodia, and expanded the peace-keeping operations in Angola. Dr. Boutros Boutros-Ghali has taken an active lead in the search for political and humanitarian interventions in Somalia, appointed a Special Representative in South Africa, dispatched two groups of technical experts to monitor the cease-fire in Mozambique and opened the historic United Nations Conference on Environment in Rio de Janeiro. He is our world leader, a tireless advocate of human rights, peace, sustainable development, and democracy. In all, a true global citizen and example to us all.

New England Circle was established by the Dunfey Family after discovering a legacy they had inherited when they first acquired the historic Parker House Hotel in Boston. In 1857 Oliver Wendall Holmes, John Greenleaf Whittier and James Russell Lowell gathered regularly at the Parker House, inviting other great thinkers of their time to discuss important social and philosophical issues. They called themselves the Saturday Club. Inspired by the concept the Dunfey Family broadened its mandate and expanded its participation.

Since inception, 7,500 people have attended. Women and men of all races, nationalities and political beliefs, young and old, rich and poor; leaders from business, labor, civic and community organizations, academia, the arts, media, clergy make up the diverse fabric of the Circles. Circles are designed to be timely and highly participatory discussions of important topics facing our communities, cities, nations and world. All circles are free of cost to participants so accessibility is guaranteed.

Recently the Circle celebrated its 75th event and next fall marks its 20th anniversary. On this occasion the Board of Directors has agreed to expand the tradition even more broadly and will be hosting Citizens Circles in communities outside of New England. Tonight we welcome new and old members of the New England Circle to another Circle, and a new Circle, the first annual Citizens Circle.
