We have profited from his influence.





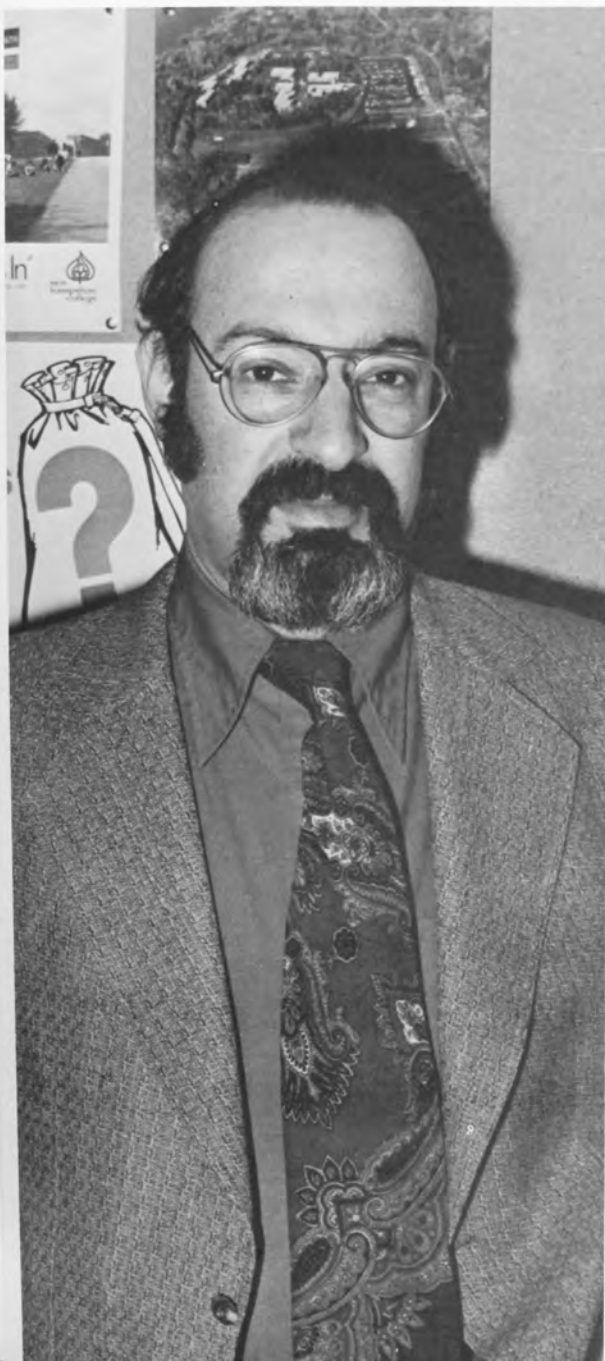
