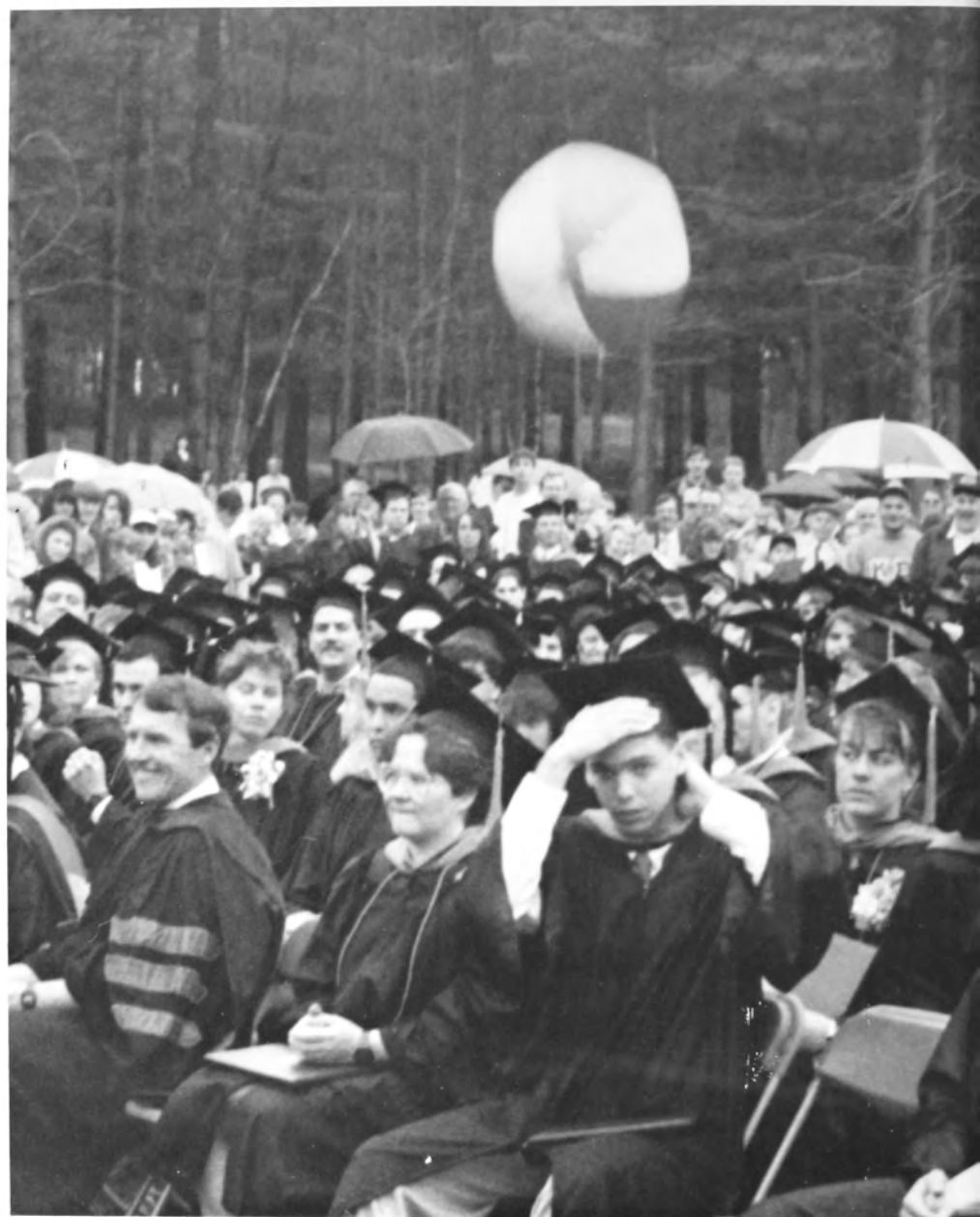

For the fifth time since 1984, the New Hampshire College women's soccer team closed out a season as Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) Division II Champions. NHC claimed the 1991 title with a 2-1 victory over defending champion LIU-Southampton in the championship game played Nov. 10 at Springfield College. The victory improved NHC's final record to 14-3-2.

After going undefeated through its first six games, NHC suffered back-to-back losses to nationally ranked Adelphi University and Springfield, and closed out the first half of the season with a 5-2-2 record. The second half of the season was highlighted with impressive wins over nationally ranked Southampton (2-1), Merrimack (3-2) and St. Anselm (2-1), but it was a 1-0 setback to cross-state rival Keene State that denied NHC its first ever bid to the NCAA Division II Tournament.

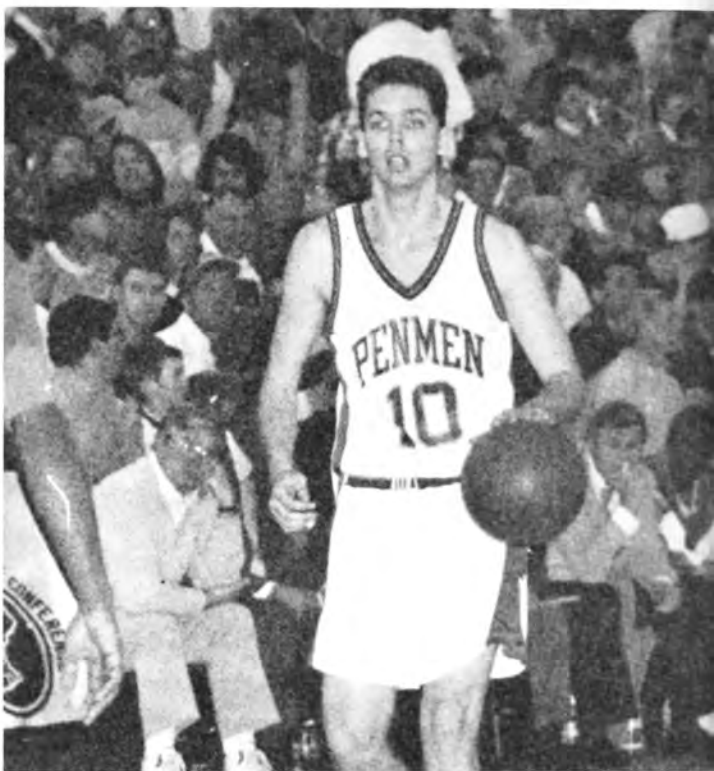

The penmen, who rolled to a 24-7 overall record, were ranked eighth in the final NCAA Division II poll and earned an at-large bid to the 1992 NCAA Division II Tournament. It marked the sixth time since 1980 that NHC earned a spot in the NCAA New England regional. Only Sacred Heart University has appeared in more New England regionals (8) since 1980. NHS was selected as the host site for the regional, March 13 & 14.

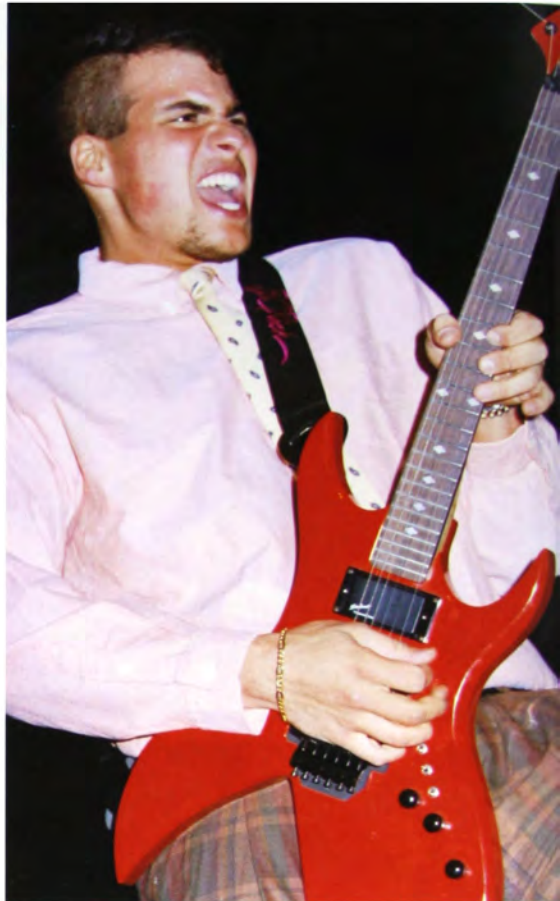






















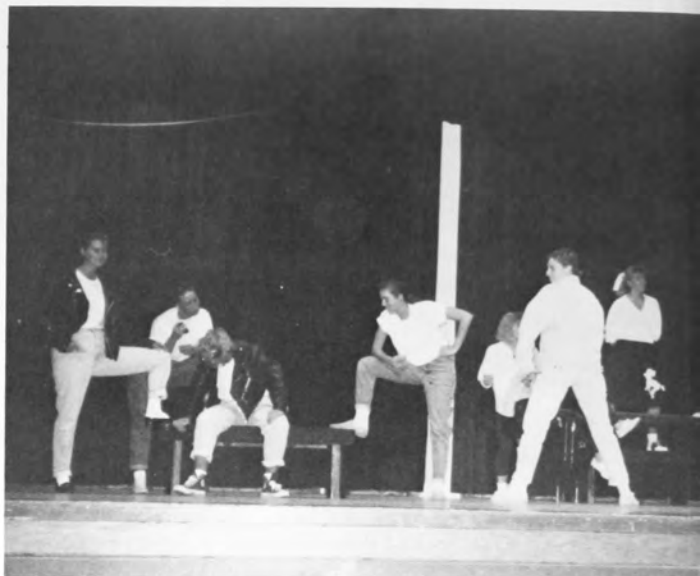
