# COMMUNITY'S NEEDS ASSESSMENT

□ Community profile: Mnyamani Street is a residential area with low-income settlement, having a population of 20400 with 443 people per square kilometer. It is located South West of the Dar-es Salaam city centre and inhabited largely with the Dar-es- Salaam natives (ZARAMO).

#### Needs assessment cont...

There are Four-Stages in this project, which were considered during needs assessment

- □ Visioning Stage
- ☐ Development Stage
- □ Refinement Stage
- ☐ Comparison Stage

# Methodology

- Data were collected at different levels. Interviews were conducted orally at both community and household level, other data were obtained via observation and secondary data were obtained from the literatures
- ☐ Sampling: Observation and interview were used and record
- □ Sample size: The entire community was used in the survey, however it was divided into zones and the needs were filtered using a sample of 6 representative from each of the five zone and prioritize them according to the importance and resources availability

#### PROBLEM IDENTIFICATION



□ Lack of community infrastructures were identified through the community needs assessment :- i.e. poor sewerage system, lack of garbage collection centres, lack of public toilets, and poor street roads.

# **Project goals**

☐ The overall goal of this project is to improve the living condition of the urban poor through community infrastructure upgrading with the community participation

### **Project objectives**

#### □ Overall Objective

The aim of the project is to strengthen the community competence and be able to improve their well being by reducing their poverty, vulnerability and social exclusion. This can be done through directly empowering the community and improve the access to affordable basic services and better living environments.

## **Specific objectives**

- □ Increase the community capacity to participate in implementation and maintenance of community infrastructure.
- Provide and improve community infrastructure; roads, drainage and sewage system, public toilet and garbage collection centers.
- ☐ Reduce the level of poverty within the community through community involvement in the project and opening room for investment.

#### **Project implementations**

- ☐ Site preparation( including compensation of those who their houses were demolished for infrastructure construction)
- □ Activities implementation which were scheduled in stages; first stage- roads construction and upgrading, second stage- construction of garbage collection centers, last stage -building of public toilets.

### **Monitoring**

- Monitoring was conducted in order to keep control of project implementation and for the committees to make good decision
- ☐ The following indicators were employed
  - 1. Effectiveness indicators
  - 2. Efficiency indicators
  - 3. Impact indicators

### Methodology

- This survey was conducted by using a cross-section research design
- ☐ Sample size: Sample size was drawn from all stakeholder of the project. 4 respondent were from the community committee, contractor involved in the work and 2 respondent from the technical committee
- The sample was obtained through simple random sampling
- □ Tools/Instrument used were; Interview, observation and records were employment

#### **Evaluations**

- Evaluation was basically based on the implementation of the highlighted upgrading needs, where questions such as,
- ☐ How can participation really be achieved in the implementation of the project?
- ☐ How can one be sure that the underprivileged are involved in the project implementation as well?
- Are the actual needs fulfilled once they are known? And,
- □ Does the community members get employed in the project during the implementation?

# Methodology used to gather evaluation information

☐ Two principal methods were employed during this evaluation:- The first one was some kind of fieldwork that entailed descriptive/diagnostic design. The second method involved library and archival investigation where information on the implementation of community infrastructure upgrading projects were gathered.

### Methodology cont..

- ☐ Sample: The area under study is divided into five zones for the purpose of this project. These blocks were utilized for the sampling procedure. From each zone 10 household were randomly selected
- Sampling Techniques: The representative sample was obtained by sing probability sampling specifically simple random sampling

# **Data Analysis** and Results **presentation**

☐ Data were analyzed by using statistical package for social science (SPSS) and inferences such as percentages and frequency to make meaning out of the quantitative data collected.

### Results presentation...

- ☐ 78 percent of the community was involved in the implementation of the project, however the number was less to that participated in needs assessment (82%)
- □ 100% of the respondents considered community participation in the project implementation is important

#### Results presentation.....

- ☐ 100% of the respondents contributed fund for the project implementation
- ☐ There were challenges which were observed.

  These includes time balancing between project work and household activities
- Lack of financial resources was also reported to be a hindering factor for full participation in the project implementation and the challenge of employed people either self or formally to participate physically in the project activities.

#### Results presentation....

- ☐ The project helps to reduce the level of poverty within the community:-It has been appreciated by 68% of the respondents that the project has increased their income either through direct employment or other activities
- ☐ The living environment has started improving.

# Recommendation and conclusion

- ☐ Community participation is still a central theme in the currently running urban upgrading projects
- ☐ Reasons to encourage participation differ from more ideological reasons to reasons concerned with efficiency. So it should be considered that the local people should have the democratic right to co-operatively decide what is best for them
