Welcome to the sixth meeting of New England Circle with Guest Speaker Senator Edward M. Kennedy of Massachusetts.

Our purpose is to assemble with others for discussion of social, political, literary, and educational topics, having as a common goal the exchange of ideas and opinions that can lead to constructive change in our nation and in our personal lives.

Senator Kennedy was elected to the United States Senate in 1962. Among his major legislative accomplishments were the establishment of Neighborhood

Health Centers, the eighteen-year-old vote, campaign financing legislation, reform of immigration laws, and creation of a Teacher Corps. He has been the sponsor of draft reform, enactment of the Safe Streets and Crime Control Act, and is recognized for his work in behalf of refugees and the suffering peoples of Biafra, Bangladesh, India, and Vietnam.

His primary legislative concerns in the present 94th Congress are the economy, energy, health insurance, comprehensive tax reform, and the role of the United States with other nations.

Senator Kennedy is a member of the Labor and Public Welfare Committee, the Judiciary Committee, the Special Committee on the Aging, and Select Committee on Nutrition and Human Needs, as well as fifteen other committees. He is the author of: In Critical Condition: The Crisis in America's Health Care; and Decisions for a Decade: Policies and Programs for the 1970's.

Previous New England Circle Guest Speakers have been Richard N. Goodwin, Dr. Henry Steele Commager, Former Governor Kenneth M. Curtis of Maine, Georgia State Senator Julian Bond, and Massachusetts Congressman Michael J. Harrington.
