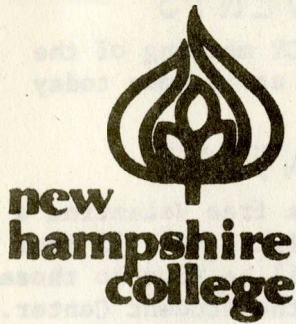

Subject: College Council Minutes - November 28, 1973

Some students are not aware of the exact wording of the motion which was passed at the November 28, 1973 College Council meeting.

"PERMISSION FOR SENIORS TO TAKE SEVEN COURSES -

Mr. Moore made the following motion: "That any full-time day student, who is a forthcoming senior and has attended full-time at New Hampshire College for two years and needs seven (7) courses each semester to graduate, be allowed, as long as the senior is in good academic standing, to take the additional academic burden without any added credit-hour expense (tuition will be the same as a 4, 5, or 6 course semester." Seconded by Brad Hughes."

This is the basis on which charges are being computed on the various student's accounts.
